<p>Settings was disabled for non-local browsers because there is no authentication front end to the web interface. However, the native browsers (surf and midori) don't seem to work (they crash) with kernel 3.10.y.</p> <p>Since I have a GTK+ based configuration tool and the settings page in the web interface work fine on remote browsers I'm re-enabling this feature for remote browsers and will look at adding some simplistic authentication front end to the web interface.</p>
